In response to the COVID-19, APCHA has partnered with the Town of Snowmass Village Housing Department and the Pitkin County Human Services department to provide support to those who have experienced additional financial hardship caused by closures and layoffs due to COVID-19.

APCHA may suspend all or a part of the 1500-hour minimum full-time work requirement for requalifying tenants who are under 1500 hours of employment and can prove that their loss of employment was due to COVID-19.
